Learning from Regional Case File Reviews

Why are the points below till the common themes in serious case reviews and learning reviews?

- The focus of the child's needs and experiences must never be lost, however demanding or distracting the parents may be.
- There are important lessons to be learnt about working with resistant and hostile parents and not losing sight of how the child experiences these behaviours.
- The child's wishes and feelings were overtaken by a concentration on the behaviour, demands and challenges of the adults.
- There was little evidence of truly child focused work that heard what the child had said and underpinned professional practice
